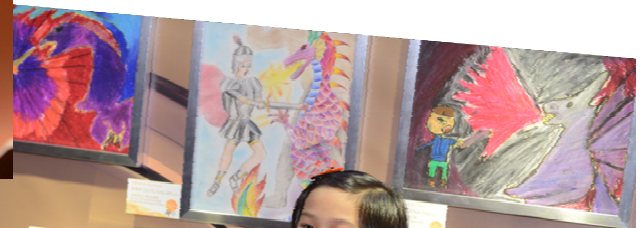
Our HK Phil players demonstrate the Wagnerian musical instruments to a wide audience.
