Yundi, piano [full biography]

Critically acclaimed for his technical precision and boundless enthusiasm, Yundi enjoys the title "prince of the piano" in China. He has been praised by the *New York Times* for his "prodigious technique, wondrous colorings, delicate passagework and steely power," as well as his "romantic





ardor, myriad colorings and bursts of hand-blurring virtuosity", in addition to being "stunningly talented".

Yundi has performed in the most prestigious music halls around the world, including sold-out concerts at the Carnegie Hall (New York), Royal Festival Hall (London), Wiener Musikverein (Vienna), the Berlin Philharmonie (Berlin), National Centre for the Performing Arts (Beijing) and Suntory Hall (Tokyo).

Renowned conductors with whom he has collaborated include James Levine, Seiji Ozawa, Gustavo Dudamel, Valery Gergiev, Daniel Harding, Lorin Maazel, Riccardo Chailly, and Yuri Temirkanov. Yundi has also collaborated with such prestigious orchestras as the Berlin Philharmonic, London Symphony Orchestra, Moscow Symphony Orchestra, NHK Symphony in Japan and Vienna Philharmonic.

Yundi has released 11 CDs and DVDs worldwide on the Deutsche Grammophon and EMI labels to enthusiastic acclaims by critics and music lovers alike, and he has received numerous awards.

#### Vassily Sinaisky, conductor [full biography]

Vassily Sinaisky's international career was launched in 1973 when he won the Gold Medal at the prestigious Karajan Competition. Soon afterwards, he was appointed Chief Conductor of the Latvian National Symphony Orchestra, a post he held from 1976 to 1987. He then became Music Director and Principal Conductor of the Moscow Philharmonic, leading numerous high-profile projects with the Orchestra both in Russia and on tour. In 2010, Sinaisky was announced as the new Chief Conductor and Music Director of the Bolshoi Theatre, Moscow. Highlights in this new role have included tours to Athens and London, and the Bolshoi's first ever production of Strauss' *Der Rosenkavalier*.

As a guest conductor Sinaisky has worked with such prestigious orchestras as the Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra, Gewandhausorchester Leipzig, NDR Sinfonieorchester Hamburg, Los Angeles Philharmonic and the Philadelphia Orchestra. Highlights of the upcoming seasons include a return to the London Philharmonic and on tour in the Netherlands.





His recordings include works by Shostakovich, Tchaikovsky, Rimsky-Korsakov, Shchedrin, Glinka, Liadov, Schreker and Szymanowski, many of which was recorded with the BBC Philharmonic.

Blessed with peerless artistic gifts and musical integrity, Yundi has become a byword for thrilling performances all around the world. His recent return to the famous recording label, Deutsche Grammophon, and his planned 2012/13 international tour set the seal on a career which has seen him rise to the very top of the virtuoso league. Vassily Sinaisky, Music Director of the Bolshoi Theatre, will also conduct Shostakovich at his most jovial: the Ninth Symphony, a boisterous celebration which like the piece sparkles champagne, and exhilarating Festive Overture which Shostakovich composed in just days for a gala celebration at the Bolshoi itself.
