Hong Kong Philharmonic Announces its 40th Professional Season (2013/14 Season)

- Maestro Jaap van Zweden's second season as Music Director sees him conducting seven varied programmes including works by Mahler, Shostakovich, Bach, Berlioz, Beethoven and Dvořák
- Maestro van Zweden leads the HK Phil in its ever complete performance of the St Matthew Passion
- There are two special programmes to celebrate Hong Kong Philharmonic's **40th Anniversary** the **HK Phil 40th Heritage Concert** and **HK Phil 40th Anniversary Gala Symphonie Fantastique**

 - Lorin Maazel Fest to celebrate Wagner's bicentenary and Britten's centenary
 - Schumann Fest featuring five events, to include all four symphonies and the two main concertos by Schumann

[7 May 2013, Hong Kong] Hong Kong Philharmonic (HK Phil) today announces the 2013/14 Season. In 1974 the HK Phil became the first professional orchestra in Hong Kong. It has been bringing beautiful music to the city ever since. In the 40th professional season, the HK Phil will present 64 main stage concerts of orchestral, instrumental and choral music featuring an impressive roll-call of over 50 guest artists and groups.

In his second season at the helm, Music Director **Jaap van Zweden** will lead the HK Phil in **14** compelling concerts in **7** weeks. To open this remarkable season, he will be joined by world renowned pianist **Jean-Yves Thibaudet** in Beethoven's *Emperor* Concerto. Other outstanding artists include pianist **Boris Berezovsky**, baritone **Matthias Goerne**, violinist **Ning Feng** and ensembles including the **Bach Choir** from London, **The Hong Kong Children's Choir** and the **Jussen Brothers** from The Netherlands.

New this Season

Lorin Maazel Fest

2014 marks not only the anniversary of the HK Phil, but also of two great musical titans – it is the bicentenary of Wagner's birth and the centenary of Britten's birth. The HK Phil is honoured to invite one of the world's greatest conductors, **Maestro Lorin Maazel**, to conduct concerts which highlight two magnificent masterpieces – **Wagner's** *The Ring Without Words* (an arrangement of Wagner's epic music by Maestro Maazel) and **Britten's** *War Requiem*. A special educational project will see the Maestro working with young instrumentalists from Hong Kong side-by-side with the HK Phil. *Maestro Maazel conducts HK Phil thanks to a generous donation from the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust*

Schumann Fest

Schumann stands at the very heart of Romantic music. Into his symphonies he poured his most personal and heartfelt emotions. In a two-week **Schumann Fest**, the HK Phil will explore this great genius in five events, performing all four of his symphonies, two concertos, selected chamber music, a lieder recital and a dialogue evening. To commence the festival, conductor **Hans Graf** will be joined by cellist **Li-Wei Qin** in Schumann's refreshing Cello Concerto sandwiched between the First and Second symphonies. Young piano virtuoso **Zhang Haochen** will showcase his artistry in Schumann's Piano Concerto and conductor **Johannes Wildner** will return with the composer's Third and Fourth symphonies. Zhang will partner the HK Phil's principal players in a **Chamber Music Concert** introducing Schumann's more intimate music. To round off the Fest, the **Lieder Recital** will bring an exquisite selection of Schumann's greatest songs. To find out more about this most enigmatic of Romantic composers, the HK Phil will present, with the generous support of the Goethe-Institut, Hong Kong, a discussion evening featuring Maestro Hans Graf in conversation with other notable Schumann authorities.

City Hall Series

Nearly 40 years to the day after its first concert as a professional orchestra, the HK Phil will join forces with its former Music Director **Maestro David Atherton** and pianist **Chen Sa** to celebrate the very first programme of 11 Jan 1974 in its original home, Hong Kong City Hall. Another two concerts not to be missed are **Jaap's Gran Partita** and **The Young Mozart** featuring HK Phil's new Concertmaster **Jing Wang** and Principal Viola **Andrew Ling**.

Roll-call of International Artists

World renowned soloists joining the HK Phil's 40th Season include Grammy Award-winning pianist **Emanuel Ax, Lang Lang, Jean-Yves Thibaudet, Boris Berezovsky**, vocalists **Sumi Jo** and **Matthias Goerne**, cellist **Sol Gabetta**, and violinists **Ning Feng** and **Patricia Kopatchinskaja**.

Distinguished guest conductors include Vladimir Ashkenazy, Hans Graf, Nicholas McGegan, Carlo Rizzi, Jun Märkl and Yu Long.

Must-See Rising Stars

2013/14 Season will also see a number of emerging young talents lighting up the Hong Kong stage. These include pianists **Zhang Haochen**, the **Jussen Brothers** and Hong Kong's new young star **Johnson Li**. More than that, this season's **Swire Maestro** series introduces two of America's most promising and



talented young conductors, Andrew Grams and Case Scaglione.

Swire Denim and Swire Sunday Family

An innovation from the last season, the **Swire Denim** and **Swire Sunday Family** series have quickly become one of the most popular musical activities in the city. The **Swire Denim Series** will feature three programmes starting at 9pm – "**Gershwin Live!**" with Gershwin himself playing 'live' with the orchestra, "**Charlie Chaplin – City Lights**" to celebrate the 125th Anniversary of the birth of this great cinematic icon, and "**The Eight Seasons**" combining the evocative "Four Seasons" of both Vivaldi and Piazzolla. **Swire Sunday Family** concerts have fast become a highlight of the weekend for Hong Kong's children, with fun activities in the Cultural Centre before and after each show, plus a chance to meet the musicians and get up close to the music.

Holiday, Pops & More

The HK Phil's acclaimed and popular **Holiday, Pops & More** series presents four happy, fun-filled concerts for all music lovers. To celebrate National Day, renowned Chinese Maestro **Zhang Guoyong** will lead the HK Phil in a programme of evergreen classics from the great Chinese folk tradition. Cellist **Trey Lee** will take up the stage for Dvořák's soulful Cello Concerto.

Hong Kong Philharmonic Chorus

After its highly acclaimed début in Handel's *Messiah* in March 2013, the **HK Phil Chorus** returns this season to feature in a number of major works including **Britten's** *War Requiem*, **Ravel's** *Daphnis et Chloé* and **Mendelssohn's** *A Midsummer Night's Dream.*

A Three-Year Composer in Residence Programme

HK Phil's new **Composer in Residence Programme**, and the **Commissioning of New Works**, are generously sponsored by **The Robert H. N. Ho Family Foundation**, with the aim of enabling emerging young Chinese composers to work closely with one of Asia's finest orchestras. Through a series of



commissioned short works created during the residency, the composer will explore the interchange between Chinese culture and the Western symphonic tradition. The first of the three composers will be **Fung Lam** whose work is to be premièred in the **HK Phil 40th Anniversary Gala** in June 2014.

CD Recording Project

In the second year of the multi-CD recording project with Naxos, the HK Phil will release works composed and conducted by the great Chinese composer, **Bright Sheng** (Programme: *Colors of Crimson* – fantasy for marimba and orchestra, *The Song and Dance of Tears* – sheng, pipa, violoncello, piano and orchestra and *The Blazing Mirage* – for violoncello and strings), featuring pianist **Chen Sa**, marimba virtuoso **Pius Cheung**, cellist **Trey Lee**, sheng player **Wu Tong** and pipa player **Li Hui**. *Sponsored by: AIA International Limited*
